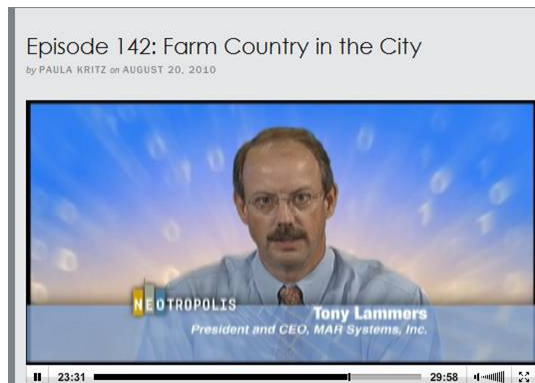

## **MAR Systems Installs Second Commercial Pilot Program**

MAR Systems is currently installing its second commercial 10gpm unit, leading to a full-scale permanent installation by mid-2011, at a major U.S. plant in Tennessee. MAR Systems manufactured the 1,000 pounds of Sorbster media needed for the pilot in its second Solon, Ohio facility.

MAR Systems is also in advanced commercial discussions with several chemical companies subject to mercury and selenium related water concerns, a major steel company and a major oil refinery facing mercury reduction requirements, and smaller industrial and municipal clients seeking to solve their mercury, selenium, arsenic and other metals issues.
