MAR Systems Initiates First Commercial Pilot Program

MAR Systems is currently installing a commercial 10gpm unit, leading to a full-scale permanent installation by mid-2011, at a major U.S. plant owned by a Fortune 500 chemical company facing mandates to substantially reduce mercury discharges into a neighboring river.

MAR Systems is also in advanced commercial discussions with several chemical companies subject to mercury-related water concerns, a major steel company and a major oil refinery facing mercury reduction requirements, and smaller industrial and municipal clients seeking to solve their mercury issues.

Other segments of potential opportunity include coal mines and coal-fired power plants, which face environmental exposure from mercury leaching and run-off, and lamp manufacturers.
